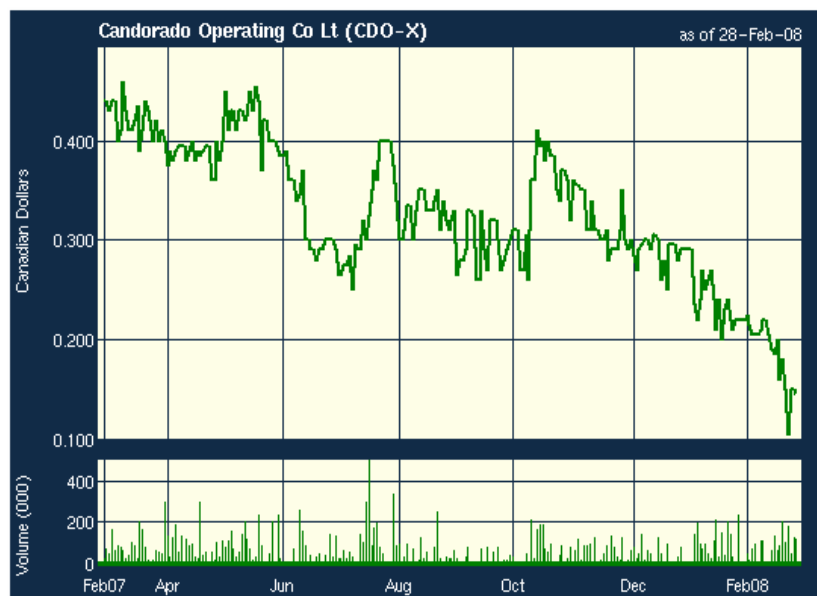

# British Columbia Properties

## Deer Lake

- The Deer Lake property covers 40 km<sup>2</sup> of gentle rolling terrain west of Little Fort in southern BC.
- Several new zones of Cu-Au bearing sulphide ± magnetite mineralization were discovered in 2007
- Diamond drilling will continue to test and delineate the new mineralization

## Friendly

- The Friendly Lake property covers 72 km<sup>2</sup> of rolling terrain 29 km west of Little Fort in south BC
- Candorado is planning an exploration program that includes prospecting, mapping and additional geochemical surveys on the newly discovered Cu-Zn showing and the large molybdenum-in-soil anomaly

## Man-Prime

- Property covers 155 km<sup>2</sup> east of Missezula Lake on the Thompson Plateau of south-central BC
- Drill hole 694-008 intercepted 120m of 0.21% Cu, 0.92g/t Au
- Candorado plans to continue the drill program in Spring 2008

## Murphy

- The property is located west of Murphy Lake and north of GWR Resources' Lac La Hache property
- Candorado plans to continue with exploration with the goal of identifying drill targets
